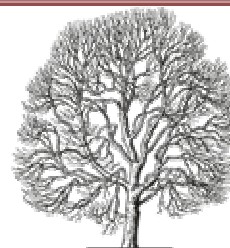

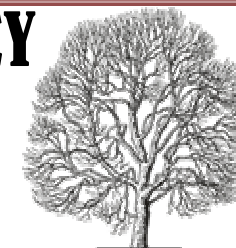

Newsletter—August 2007



The first year of the newly established parish council has been extremely busy with the council getting involved in a number of projects and dealing with many local issues. One of the first issues the parish council had to deal with was the access problems at Havenstreet recreation ground. The side entrance to the ground was closed off due to health and safety reasons, therefore the parish council worked closely with the IWC to ensure there were improvements made to the main entrance. Over time, it became apparent that these initial improvements were not sufficient and that more work needed to be undertaken in the area to improve safety. After further site meetings with the IWC, it has been agreed that a passing place will be provided to allow two vehicles to pass on the corner, retention work will be carried out on the bank and a large drop down security post will be installed on the entrance itself. New warning signs will also be positioned on the approaches to entrance. This combination of improvements will make the entrance much safer for pedestrians and also improve road safety on this blind bend in Church Road.

The parish council has recently received £5000 funding from an Awards for All Grant (Lottery) to set up a parish office and to produce the parish plan. The parish office will be located in Havenstreet Community Centre and will give residents the opportunity to talk to the Clerk or any of their Councillors. Local problems can be reported, council documents can be viewed, and all current planning applications can be inspected.

This grant funding has also enabled internet access to be provided at the centre and two laptop computers to be purchased. During the parish office opening times, residents can visit the centre to use the internet free of charge. The Parish Clerk will be on hand to assist with any problems. A range of computer courses will also be run at the centre. Please complete the form on the back page of this newsletter if you would like to take part one or more of these courses.
